

STRATHMORE FOOTBALL CLUB LIFE MEMBERSHIP CRITERIA

The Strathmore Football Club bestows Life Membership on worthy and deserving individuals of this honour who have rendered outstanding voluntary and unpaid service.

This voluntary service falls in two categories: -

1. A minimum of ten years' service as the President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, a member of the Executive Committee, Head of Senior Football and Head of Junior Football.
2. A minimum of fifteen years' service as a member of the General Committee, Communication Person, Events Person, Football Manager, Junior Coordinators, Senior and Junior Coaches, Club Captain, Senior Trainer, Senior and Junior Team Managers, and Junior Coaching and Development Officer.

Players who have represented the club in an exemplary manner and have played a minimum 200 Senior/Reserve games or 150 Senior/Reserve games combined with 150 Junior games, along with a minimum of 3 years' service in categories 1 and 2 must be performed before they are considered. This can be served concurrently.

Other Members with exceptional circumstances may be considered.

Consideration for Life Membership is open to nominations by financial club members. This must be lodged in writing and provide proof of the criteria above of the nominee's service. It will need to be seconded by 2 other financial members and lodged by the 31st of October 2022 to the Life Members Committee. The Life Members Committee will consider and verify that all nominations meet the criteria. The nominees must receive a majority approval, by ballot, from the Life Members Committee. A maximum of 2 nominees in any given year will be presented to the Executive Committee for endorsement.

This Life Membership Criteria has been approved by the Football Club Executive Committee.

The Life Membership Luncheon will be held early in season 2023.
